POST PCI ORDERS

ACTIVITY:

- 1. If you had a Coronary angiogram via the Groin: Do NOT lift anything more than 5 lbs for 1 week.
- 2. If you had a Coronary Angiogram via the Arm: Do NOT lift anything more than 10 lbs with arm that the IV was in for 5 days.
- 3. No driving for 24 hours.

WOUND CARE:

1. Do NOT apply creams, lotions, or ointments over the incision site.

SPECIAL ATTENTION:

- 1. If you had an "IV" (vascular access) via the arm, if you notice any significant swelling, bleeding, or fevers, apply pressure over the incision site and seek medical attention
- 2. If you had an "IV" (vascular access) via the groin, if you notice any significant, bleeding, fevers, or abdominal / back pain, please seek medical attention.
- 3. Do NOT strain during bowel movements for the next 5 days.
- 4. You will follow up in Clinic in _____ weeks

MEDICATIONS:

- You MUST take Aspirin + Plavix (also called Clopidigrel). Do NOT stop taking these unless your cardiologist tells you that it is okay to stop them
- 2. Failure to take your medications, including PLAVIX could potentially result in a fatal heart attack. If it helps, set an alarm or timer (your phone might have an alarm) to help remind you take it.
- 3. TAKE YOUR PLAVIX EVERYDAY!
